



We recommend that each campus resident bring an emergency survival kit and be prepared to take care of themselves for at least 72 hours in case of an emergency.

## WHY YOU NEED AN EMERGENCY KIT

Emergencies can happen at any time. Having a kit ensures you're ready for power outages, severe weather, earthquakes, or other disruptions. Your kit should include essentials to keep you safe, healthy, and connected.

BASIC EMERGENCY KII	EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM (ENS)
Pack enough supplies for at least 3 days:	Sonoma State uses the Emergency Notification System (ENS) to send emergency updates via voice
